

## **ANNUAL REPORT 2017 - 2018**

Kavi Bharathi Vidyalaya was established on 24<sup>th</sup> June 1991 with strength of just 54 students. The family has expanded to a total strength of 1,247 students and 77 teachers.

The vision of being a school with a difference has been fulfilled through the untiring efforts of all our stakeholders. We provide holistic education while ensuring all round development of our students, in setting the highest levels of moral standards and values.

The academic year began in **April**. We started with welcoming our children, had Aksharabhayasa for kindergarten. Then we moved on to nomination and elections of student council. Every year student council members are elected by the students themselves through electronic voting system.

Teachers are the back bone of a school. Empowerment programmes for teachers are done throughout the year. Management provides outbound 3day programme for all staff in the last week of April. It was held at House of Peace, Yercaud. The teachers were trained on :

Teachers attended various workshops, conferences and trainings for their professional development.
