Board Examination – March 2025

The academic year 2025–26 concluded on a triumphant note with the Board Examinations in March 2026. Our students' cent percent result reflected their diligence, perseverance, and the steadfast mentorship of their teachers. Adding to this distinction, Class X students achieved two centum in Science, one centum in Tamil, while a Class XII student attained a centum in Informatics Practices.

Academic Year Opening – June 4, 2026

The academic year 2026–27 commenced on June 4, 2026, with the campus abuzz with renewed enthusiasm and anticipation. Students were warmly welcomed through engaging activities that created a positive and inspiring atmosphere for the year ahead.

Students' Council Election – April 10, 2026

Tamizhodu Vilaiyadu

Our students brought great pride to our school by competing with 3,036 students from 1,012 schools across 38 districts in the linguistic competition 'Tamilodu Vilaiyadu' conducted by Kalaignar TV, and won the 3rd prize with a cash award of Rs. 75,000/-

INSPIRE-MANAK Award

Our students brought distinction to Kavi Bharathi Vidyalaya through the prestigious INSPIRE Awards – 2025–26, instituted by the Government of India, Ministry of Science and Technology. Dushyant of Class X and Aadithyanth of Class VIII were among the selected students from Tamil Nadu for their innovative projects, “Smart Walking Stick” and “Every Drop Counts”, respectively. Both projects advanced to the next level of evaluation, with each student receiving a cash award of ₹10,000. Among 2,236 selected projects from Tamil Nadu, the selection of two projects from our school is a remarkable achievement, reflecting our students' innovation, scientific acumen, and problem-solving prowess.

Career Guidance Programme (CGP)
